



Travel to India set to become more expensive

Expats looking to go back home to **India** over the upcoming festive season may be in for a shock.

An expected price hike in costs of tickets could see air fares jump by as much as five to ten per cent in the next four months, according to predictions made by market analysts, reported the Economic Times.
